

# Rate Increase

Dear Valued Customer,

Starting July 1, 2025, the rates for collection and disposal of recycling, trash and organics will increase, due to an increase in operational costs.

The specific increase for each residential account is determined by the size of the waste cart. The table below shows the new monthly rates for July 2025 and previous monthly rates from 2024.

- ✓ Appointment-based pickup of home-generated sharps

- ✓ Holiday tree pickup (December 26 – January 31 on organics collection day)
- ✓ A trip to the dump once per year (up to 5 cubic yards)

Customers may also have up to two additional mixed recycling carts and up to two additional organics carts at no extra cost. By committing to recycling more and disposing less, residents can reduce their trash cart size and lower their monthly rate.

Elk Grove residents may pick up free compost at the Elder Creek Transfer Station with no appointment required. Compost is self-loaded and limited to 5 cubic yards twice a year.
