Services for No Additional Cost

Each calendar year (January 1 - December 31), residential customers are entitled to one (1) bulky item pick up at no additional cost.

On-Call Curbside Pickup

Each calendar year (January 1- December 31), residential customers are entitled to two (2) on-call curbside cleanups of non-hazardous waste at no extra cost. On-call 15-bag cleanup is limited to 15 bags. On-call 15-bag cleanups can be used either for regular waste or yard waste only (mixed waste will be collected and disposed as trash). Bags must be no larger than 35 gallons, weigh no more than 40 pounds, and be strong enough to hold the materials without breaking.

Cleanups will be made on the customer's regular waste or yard waste collection day. For more information, please visit **Richmondsanitaryservice.com**. To schedule your annual on-call curbside cleanups of bagged waste or all yard waste only, please call **510.262.7100** at least one week in advance. Extra charges apply to same-week cleanups.

Additional Services

Prepaid Bag Ties

Residential customers with occasional extra waste may purchase prepaid bag ties by mail. Mail orders are sent by certified mail with return receipt at an additional cost for postage.

Backyard Carry-Out Service

Special arrangements may be made for households where none of the occupants are physically able to move carts to the curb for collection. Medical certification of disability is required and must be renewed annually. This service is available to others at an additional cost.

Debris Boxes

Republic Services is the only collector authorized to collect recyclables and waste in West County. Debris boxes from 10 to 40 yards are available for 3-day rentals for household remodeling, landscape projects, site cleanups or other projects. Call **510.262.7100** for rates or to place an order.

Report Illegal Dumping

If you see someone dumping trash on the side of the road, a vacant lot or in a creek. Call **800.NO.DUMPING**.

Billing and Payments

Residential customers are billed quarterly. Bills are due upon receipt and are considered past due at the end of the first month of the billing period. Past due accounts are subject to late payment charges applied at 60 days.

Extra Waste

Carts filled above the rim, refilled or compacted carts, or additional waste beyond the service subscription level, are considered extra waste and are subject to an extra charge. Please call our customer service department **510.262.7100** in advance to make arrangements for extra waste collection service.

Collection Guidelines

- Face carts toward the street with wheels against the curb or gutter by 6 a.m. on your service day.
- Allow at least 2 feet between carts and 5 feet between carts and other objects.
- Make sure lids are securely shut materials should not extend beyond the cart rim.
- If carts are not out on collection day, customers have the option to wait until the next week for pickup or request a return trip for an additional charge.
- Carts not placed out for collection are not eligible for credit.
- Do not put hot ashes, dirt, rocks, concrete or hazardous items in your black or brown or blue or green cart.

Curbside Bagged On-Call Yard Waste Cleanup

Your annual on-call bagged cleanup can be used for all yard waste (no food scraps or regular waste). Call at least one week in advance to schedule.

Extra charges apply to same-week cleanup. Yard waste in compostable bags set out with your green cart on your regular service day without scheduling a cleanup are subject to extra waste charges. Compostable and paper bags are the only bags that can be used for yard waste cleanup collections. For more information, contact Customer Service at 510.262.7100

Do not throw leftover household hazardous waste into the recycling, trash or organics carts. It is very toxic for people and the environment. The West County Household Hazardous Waste Facility accepts household hazardous waste at its drive-through drop-off center at no charge to all residents of the Republic Services service area (Unincorporated West Contra Costa County, Richmond, San Pablo, Pinole, Hercules, Rodeo, Crockett, Port Costa and Tormey) and other parts of West Contra Costa County. Proof of residency required. The HHW Reuse Area offers free materials such as fertilizers, paint and other useful items, as well as information on alternative products less harmful to our environment.

Acceptable Materials

Limited to 15 gallons or 125 pounds of total material.

- Paint, aerosol cans, adhesives, resins and putties
- Liquid and solid poisons (pesticides, cleaners, fertilizers)
- Acids and oxidizers (pool chemicals, bleaches, detergents)
- Reactive wastes (drain cleaners)
- Gas barbecue tanks less than 5 gallons
- Household batteries
- Fluorescent lamps, tubes and bulbs
- Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
- Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Mercury-containing thermometers, thermostats and timers
- CPUs and peripherals
- VCR / DVD players and radios
- Cell / cordless telephones and answering machines
- Computer monitors and TVs (no wood cabinets)
- Over-the-counter and prescription drugs (no controlled substances)
- Home-generated sharps (needles, syringes, lancets) in biohazard red puncture-resistant cart

Unacceptable Materials

- Radioactive materials
- Explosives (including firearms)
- Medical waste
