Make spring cleaning simple and sustainable! Take advantage of your no-cost disposal options this season.

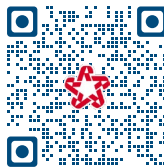


Two (2) On-Call Curbside Pickups Per Year

Rodeo residents may schedule up to two (2) fifteen (15) 35-gal. bagged cleanups each year! Each bag must be of all household trash or all yard waste material only. Mixed setouts will be discarded as trash.

One (1) Bulk Item Cleanup Per Year

Rodeo residents may schedule up to one (1) bulky item cleanup each year at no additional cost! Items must weigh less than 200 lbs. A bulk item may be substituted for 5 electronic waste items.

Bags to Bins Guide

The right bag matters! Plastic bags slow processing and reduce quality, and can be considered **contamination** in organics or recycling. Sort smartly, and do your part by using an acceptable bag.

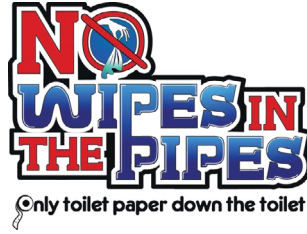

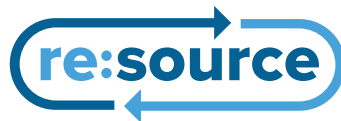


When in Doubt, Find Out!
