Acceptable Items

- ✓ Electronics
- ✓ Household cleaners, aerosols and sprays
- ✓ Paints, stains, solvents and pesticides
- ✓ Pharmaceuticals (no controlled substances)
- ✓ Fluorescent bulbs and batteries
- ✓ Automotive fluids and car batteries

What you need to know:

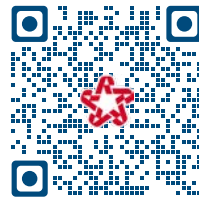
- Bring proof of residency
- Drive-through service only

Unacceptable Items

- ✗ Explosives, including firearms
- ✗ Radioactive materials
- ✗ Medical waste
- ✗ Pressurized gas cylinders more than 5 gal.

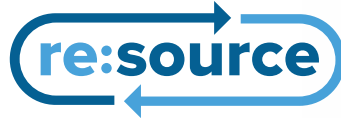


When in Doubt, Find Out!
