Convenient Curbside Collections Available at No Cost!

We're excited to highlight new programs providing Unincorporated County residents convenient disposal options for their extra waste - right from your curb!



Curbside Collection

Get collection for up to fifteen (15) 35-gallon trash bags of non-hazardous household waste or all green waste. Bundled branches will be accepted with green waste setouts. **Compostable bags or paper leaf bags must be used for all other green waste curbside collection. Bags should weigh no more than 40 pounds and should be strong enough to hold materials without breaking.**



Bulk Item Collection

Get collection for big items, like furniture, major appliances, mattresses, box springs, water heaters, carpet, bathroom fixtures, large toys, car seats, electronic waste or other items that are too large to fit in your cart. Unincorporated County residents are eligible for one (1) bulk item collection event of up to two (2) items. The two (2) items may be substituted for 10 electronic waste items. **Weight and item limits apply.**

Call our Customer Service department at **510.262.7100** at least one week in advance to schedule a curbside or bulk item pickup. Extra charges apply for same-week collection.
