Leaf Collection Schedule (Where Available)

Few things are more beautiful in the Willamette Valley than autumn leaves taking on their fall colors. Here's the schedule for leaf pickup, depending on where you live. Rake your leaves (no branches or brush!) into the street just before your weekly collection day. Rows should be long and narrow and 2 feet away from the curb. Be sure you don't block bike lanes, storm drains, or driveways.

- **Albany:** Leaves are collected throughout all of Albany during each round. Rake leaves into the street just before leaf pickup weeks.
 - o Round 1: October 21 – November 1
 - o Round 2: November 4 – November 15
 - o Round 3: December 2 – December 13
- **Lebanon:** The City of Lebanon typically picks up leaves in November. Stay tuned to the city website or [Facebook page](#) for announcements as the time nears. Republic Services does not pick up leaves in Lebanon.

PRO TIP 🗋️ First, fill your organics cart with leaves before raking the remainder into the street. You'll get rid of them faster and keep streets cleaner.

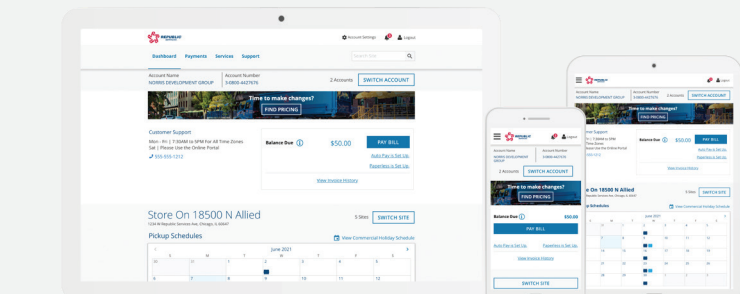
