
## Cardboard and Cartons



Flattened cardboard, packaging boxes, and food and beverage cartons

Pizza boxes must be empty with no food residue.

## Paper



Newspaper, magazines, office paper, paper egg cartons, mail, paperback books, paper bags, and non-metallic gift wrap

## Plastic



Bottles, round containers, buckets, and rigid plant pots

Caps OK if screwed on. All items must be 2 inches by 2 inches or larger.

## Metal



Aluminum and steel cans, and scrap metal

## Glass



Bottles and jars

Remove caps and lids.

Place in glass-only bin

**No!**

Please do not place these common contaminants in the recycling.



No bagged recyclables



No foam



No food or liquid  
(empty all containers)



No plastic bags  
or stretchy plastics  
(store or depot drop-off)



No hoses,  
cords, or wires

## Set carts out by 5 a.m.

- ✓ Set carts out with handles toward the house.
- ✓ Do not block cars, bike lanes, mailboxes, sidewalks or driveways.
- ✓ Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.



### Note: Drivers work on all holidays.

There will be no delays in collection for any holiday. Please set carts out the night before, as the drivers might come by earlier than usual.

- Recycling, Trash and Yard Waste** - Picked up weekly.
- Recycling, Trash, Yard Waste and Glass** - During blue weeks, place the glass cart curbside.
- Household Hazardous Waste Event** - City of Lebanon Shops - 305 W. Oak Street  
Saturday, April 4 (from 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.)
- Recycling Roundup Events** - Saturday, May 2, at City of Lebanon Shops (from 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.)

**Christmas Tree Pickup** - Monday, December 28, 2026 - Friday, January 15, 2027.

Place your tree curbside on your regular service day (all decorations must be removed; no flocked trees).

**Christmas Light Collection** - 1214 SE Montgomery Street, Albany, OR 97322, Monday, November 23 - Friday, January 15, 2027. Drop off lights at the Republic Services office.
