



# The Recycle Plus Collection Service for the City of Bend



## Recycle Plus is a new subscription-based pickup service for hard-to-recycle items.

The monthly subscription cost is \$10.39. Each on-call pickup is \$5.20. We provide on-call service the second Friday of each month.

### HOW TO PREPARE YOUR MATERIAL:


- 1** You'll receive a purple bin and 10 plastic bags for Recycle Plus materials.
- 2** Sort all materials by listed categories into separate bags, then place them in the purple bin.
- 3** All sorted bagged materials must fit in the container, and the lid must close completely to keep materials dry.
- 4** On-call pickup is the 2nd Friday of every month. To schedule a service, email us at least 2 days prior to ensure service.
- 5** Place your bin on your doorstep prior to 5 a.m.
- 6** Materials that don't fit in the bin must be separately bagged by type and set next to the bin for pickup.

## ACCEPTED MATERIAL CATEGORIES:




### Plastic Film / Plastic Bags

Soft, flexible polyethylene (PE) packaging free of food residue. Examples include plastic bags, dry cleaning bags, padded envelopes, produce bags, plastic overwrap for paper towels, paper plates, napkins, etc.



### Clear Plastic #1 Clamshell Containers

Cleaned and rinsed one-piece containers hinged on one side. Examples include fruit and vegetable containers, plastic egg cartons, bakery containers and take-out containers. **This program does not currently accept opaque plastic containers, trays, cups, bottles or non-hinged containers.**



### Styrofoam™

We understand that most Styrofoam™ sizes will not fit in the designated bin. Please bag extra materials, and put the bag outside and next to the bin for pickup.



### Textiles

Any type of cloth or fabric. Examples include bedding, clothing, towels, fabric and shoes. **This program does not currently accept purses, pillows or cushions.**



### Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs

Fluorescent bulbs that are curved or folded to fit the space of a regular household lamp. **This program does not currently accept incandescent bulbs, halogens, LED bulbs or fluorescent tubes.**



### Batteries

Examples include household batteries (A, C, D and 9-volt), single-use or rechargeable, and button batteries.
