All food, including meat, seafood, fruits, vegetables, dairy products, bakery items, rice, pasta, beans, coffee grounds and filters, tea leaves, egg shells, bones, sauces and paper napkins.

- Foil
- · Grease and oils
- Seafood shells
- Foodware

- Compostable dishware (including to-go containers and disposable cups)
- Utensils
- Metal

Food Waste Collection

Republic Services offers a food waste collection program for commercial businesses within the Bend, Redmond and Sisters city limits. This program gives commercial customers another opportunity to further reduce their trash, recycle more and keep organic waste out of the landfill.

It's Easy!

Fill your food waste cart with any food waste material, including meat, produce, dairy and bakery items. We'll empty and rinse the cart at least once a week. The material goes to Deschutes Recycling, where it will be processed into nutrient-rich compost.

Service

We offer 65-gallon roll carts to collect your food waste material. We can provide as many carts as needed. Carts are serviced once or twice weekly, depending on your needs. Carts are rinsed clean each time they are serviced.

Fees

The monthly fee will depend on the number of carts and the frequency of service. Contact Republic Services, and we will schedule a representative to meet with you to determine the best program to fit your needs.
