## Acceptable Items



## Plastics

Recycle plastics #1, #2 and #5. Look on the bottom of containers for the number inside the recycling arrows.



**Metal Cans** Recycle all food and beverage metal cans—steel, tin, and aluminum.



**Cardboard, Newspaper & Magazines** Recycle newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



**Paper Food Containers & Cartons** Egg cartons (plastic or cardboard), cereal and pasta boxes.



**Paper** Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders.



**Glass** Recycle clear, brown and green bottles and jars.



**Don't bag it!** Put your recyclables loose in your recycling cart.

Please make sure your recyclables are **empty, clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.
