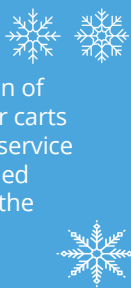


Inclement Weather

✓ Empty, clean and dry



Cardboard

✓ Flatten boxes
✓ 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max
✓ Keep clean and dry



Metal Containers

✓ Empty, clean and dry



Glass Bottles & Jars

✓ Empty, clean and dry
✓ Unbroken
✗ No lids



Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Tubs

✓ Empty, clean and dry



Trash/Basura

✓ Bag all trash
✓ If the item is not on the recycling list, place it in the trash

✗ No hot ashes or coals

✗ No hazardous waste



Your trash dumpster may be blue.

Food-Soiled Packaging

✓ Food-soiled or plastic-coated (anything squishy or clingy)



*Place in compost if available.

Polystyrene Foam

✓ Recycle for free at StyroRecycle.com



Diapers & Pet Waste

✓ Double-bagged



Household Items

✓ Latex paint cans (dry or empty)
✓ Visit Paintcare.org for paint recycling information

Food Waste/Desechos Alimentarios



✓ Keep compost container near the sink
✓ Add food scraps and food-soiled paper, such as napkins
✓ When full, empty into your yard waste cart
