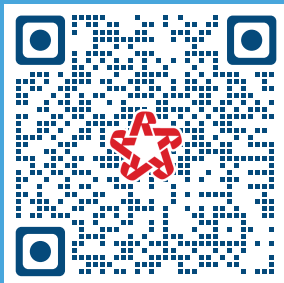

## Easy Food Scrap Recycling/ *Fácil reciclaje de restos de comida*



1. Keep compost container near the sink
2. Add food scraps and food-soiled paper, such as napkins
3. When full, empty into your yard waste cart

## Food-Soiled Paper/*Papel con manchas de comida*



**Available Cart Sizes:** 32-Gallon, 64-Gallon, 96-Gallon

- ✓ Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK
- ✓ Extras may be placed in paper lawn bags, boxes or cans clearly labeled "yard waste". Untreated wood/branches may be bundled with natural twine (max is 4 ft. x 2 ft.) No food scraps in extra containers.

- ✓ Extras may be collected in securely tied plastic bags and clearly labeled as "trash" (max. 60 lbs.) Fees apply for each extra 32-gallon unit of garbage

# Other Service Benefits

- **Rate Discounts:** receive 50% off your rate if your total household income is less than the federal HUD guidelines, and you are 62 or older, disabled, or the parent or guardian of a disabled minor. Call **206.682.9735** to apply.
- **Carry-Out Service:** Free cart carry-out service is available for disabled customers. Fee-based service is available for all customers. Call **206.682.9735** to enroll.
- **Free Cart Cleaning:** Your food and yard waste cart can be cleaned once a year at no charge. Call **206.682.9735** to sign up.
- **Paperless Billing:** Receive a monthly discount of \$0.20 if you enroll in paperless billing.

# Special Item Recycling

**FREE:** Call **206.682.9735** to schedule a curbside collection.  
**DO NOT** put these items in your cart.



Fluorescent bulbs and tubes  
(put bulbs in sealed, clear bags; wrap  
tubes in paper, secure with tape and  
label "fluorescent tubes")



Motor oil: Limit 2 gallons per residence.  
Label container with name and address.  
Place in clear, plastic jugs with screw-top.  
Leave next to recycling cart for collection.



Rigid plastics: 5-gallon buckets, PVC pipe, plastic  
lawn furniture, coolers, plastic laundry baskets, etc.



Small household appliances

**FEE-BASED:** Call **206.682.9735** to schedule a collection



Large appliances:  
fridges, dryers, ovens,  
water heaters, etc.



Bulky items:  
mattresses, couches,  
furniture, etc.



Large scrap metal  
(all metal; no  
coating  
or grease)



Wood waste, untreated  
and unpainted (place in  
cardboard box and label  
"wood waste")

# Inclement Weather

If weather conditions prevent the safe collection of your recycling, garbage or yard and food waste,  
your cart will be collected on your next regular service day.



# Cart Placement


Set carts out by 7 a.m. with  
handles facing toward the  
house. Do not block cars,  
mailboxes, sidewalks or  
roadways. Remove carts  
as soon as possible after  
collection.







# 2025 Calendar (Set Out Carts by 7 a.m.)

Set carts out with handles facing the house. Do not block cars, mailboxes, sidewalks or driveways. Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.

 **Holidays** - No service on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. If collection falls mid-week, the collection day will shift one day the rest of the week (i.e., Tuesday collection will occur Wednesday).

 **Recycling** - During blue weeks, place your recycling cart curbside next to your garbage cart.


 **Food & Yard Waste** - During green weeks, place your yard and food waste cart curbside next to your garbage cart.

 **Spring/Fall Cleanup** - During this week, place extra garbage and yard waste out on your pickup day at no extra cost. Limited to ten, 32-gallon units for each waste type. More information at [KentWA.gov/TalkingTrash](https://kentwa.gov/TalkingTrash)

 **Recycling Event** - Free collection event on March 1, June 14 and October 11.

 **Christmas Tree Pickup:** In January, place your undecorated and unflocked Christmas tree next to your waste cart for pickup at no charge. Trees must be less than 6'.

**Extra Garbage:** Next to your primary garbage cart, place securely tied plastic bags (max. 60 lbs.) or 32-gallon lidded cans labeled "garbage." Fees will apply to each additional unit and to primary carts without closed lids.
